FAMILY BACKGROUND: Angie Robinson was born in 1921 to Emily Benjamin Robinson and Jeffery Robinson in Calhoun County, South Carolina. She was the second eldest of six siblings (James Robinson born 1915, Johnny Robinson (adopted brother) born 1921, Flossie Robinson born 1922, Lurlene Robinson born 1924, and Jannie Robinson born 1928. Angie Robinson married Vandy Kennedy in 1934. That union produced fourteen children, Janie Kennedy, Vandy Kennedy Jr., James Kennedy, Pauline Kennedy, Athell Kennedy, Dorothy Kennedy, Gloria Kennedy, Russell Kennedy, Johnny Kennedy, Katherine Kennedy, Patricia Kennedy, Gwendolyn Kennedy, Cherry Kennedy and Harriet Kennedy. She also raised two grandsons, Rodney A. Kennedy and Lloyd B. Bullard.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Angie Kennedy's greatest accomplishment was the raising of her children and the values, principles and spiritual teachings that she instilled in each of them. While she never completed secondary education she continuously stressed the importance of formal education, tertiary education and vocational training. 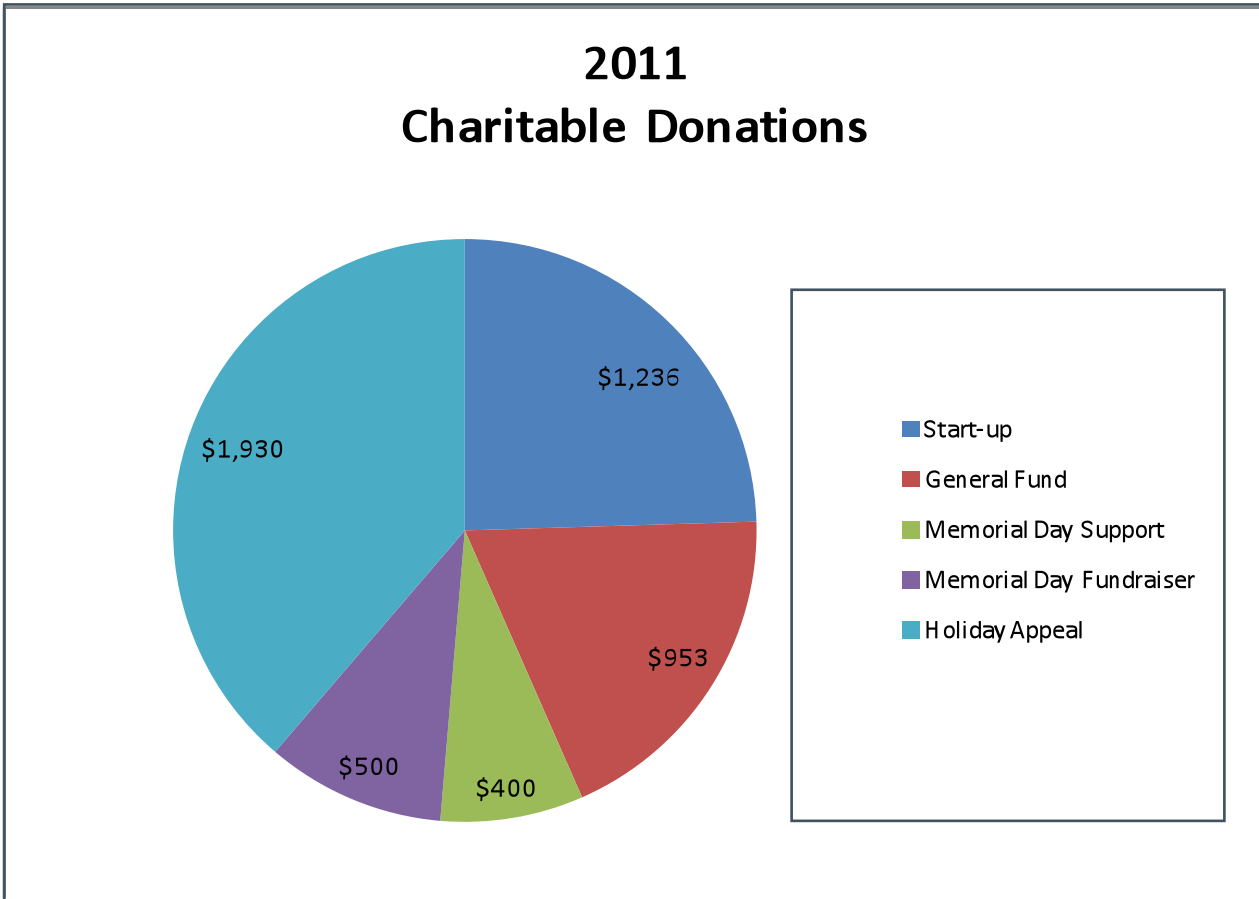
